## STEP 1: ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST



Get started at the Enrollment Center. Meet with a team member who will be your guide through the enrollment checklist. This meeting can be in-person, over the phone or virtual and is designed to simplify the process and ensure you are supported at every step of your Ivy Tech journey! Your first step is to apply to the college for FREE at [ivytech.edu/apply-now](https://ivytech.edu/apply-now). Next you'll want to apply for financial aid at [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov) (use school code 009917). Ivy Tech has awarded \$228 million in scholarships, grants, and work-study and more than 70% of all students qualify for financial aid!



Verify your MyIvy username and set your password at [myivy.ivytech.edu](https://myivy.ivytech.edu). It's important to check your @ivytech.edu email account for important registration and financial aid updates. You'll need your Student ID (C#) to log in. Your C# will be sent to you by mail and to the email address submitted on your application.



Make sure the classes you take are the right fit! You can complete this in any of the following ways:

- Submit your ACT, SAT or PSAT scores, High School GPA or previous college credit and transcripts for consideration.
- Complete the Knowledge Assessment at [myivy.ivytech.edu](https://myivy.ivytech.edu) – if you don't have any of the items listed above, don't worry! You can access and complete our FREE Knowledge Assessment tool. After you complete the assessment you will have a chance to improve your scores through your customized learning path to better prepare you for courses.
- Decision to opt-out and start at developmental courses.

## STEP 2: REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

The Financial Responsibility Agreement (FRA) outlines your financial obligations as a student and the policies related to your enrollment. You're required to read and complete the FRA via ScheduleBuilder or IvyPay before registering for classes.
