What do I need to do before enrolling?

You will also need to take the college entrance exam, COMPASS test. This is not a pass/fail test. It is simply a test to help our counselors determine the level of coursework at which you should begin.

How do I register?

After completing the COMPASS test you will need to contact the Admissions Office (812) 246.3301, Ext. 4136 or toll-free at 1-800-321-9021 to complete the admissions process and make an appointment to meet with your counselor.

How do I determine which courses I should take?

There are two accelerated degree options: Business Management which takes approximately 24-months and Design Technology which will take approximately 24 months for completion.

How much does it cost to enroll?

Ivy Tech Community College has one of the lowest tuition fees in the State of Indiana. It is \$91.30 for Indiana residents and also includes Jefferson, Oldham and Bullitt Counties in Kentucky.

You will also be assessed a \$40 technology fee and a \$10 per credit hour fee, if applicable, for internet courses.

Are books included?

Textbooks or supplies (if needed) are not included in the tuition cost. Books can be delivered to your home or business. (Delivery charge will be assessed.)

Is the College for Working Adults Initiative eligible for Financial Aid?

Yes, the program is a regular degree seeking college program.

Will my Ivy Tech class credits transfer?
