If you do not have a PIN or have forgotten your PIN please visit <http://www.pin.ed.gov>. Your electronic counseling results take approximately 5 business day to load into Banner Self Service.

## OBTAINING YOUR LOAN HISTORY:

If you have borrowed a student loan prior to Summer 2011, please access your loan history as instructed below, and **attach a screen print** to this loan request form.

Step 1: Go to the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS): [http://www.nsls.ed.gov/nsls\\_SA/](http://www.nsls.ed.gov/nsls_SA/).

Step 2: Use the Personal Identification Number (PIN) that was established when you completed your FAFSA online. If you do not remember your PIN, visit <http://www.pin.ed.gov>. **(Be sure to keep your PIN safe and secure.)**

Step 3: Go to [http://www.nsls.ed.gov/nsls\\_SA/](http://www.nsls.ed.gov/nsls_SA/), click on *Financial Aid Review*; the *Gathering Your Information* screen will appear. Read the privacy statement and, if you agree, click *Accept* to continue the process.

Step 4: Enter your PIN, Social Security Number (SSN), the first two letters of your last name, and your date of birth to confirm your identity.

Step 5: View the *Financial Aid Review* screen, which lists details about your prior loans. **PRINT THE SCREEN** and attach a copy to this loan request form. If you have questions about this screen, call the U. S. Department of Education at 1-800-4FEDAID (1-800-433-3243).
