



Crossroads Scholarship Information Continuing Student - Crossroads Scholar 2009-2010 Academic Year

Ivy Tech-Northeast and IPFW are pleased to announce the availability of two half-tuition scholarships for Crossroads students. These merit scholarships are awarded annually. Eligibility is not based on financial need. The scholarship committee, comprised of representatives from both Ivy Tech-Northeast and IPFW, will select the recipients after a review of the applicant's academic performance, letter of recommendation, and career goal statement. Application forms may be downloaded from the Crossroads website at www.ivytech.edu/fortwayne/crossroads. Applications are due **March 13, 2009**. Applicants need one letter of recommendation and a career goal essay of not longer than one page. See the back page for the application form and required documents. Incomplete applications will not be considered.



Crossroads Scholar: Two half-tuition scholarships will be awarded to Crossroads students who have successfully completed their degree program and maintained a cumulative GPA of 3.5. Priority will be given to students completing the associate of science degree at Ivy Tech–Northeast in an articulated program of study at IPFW.

Recipients will automatically be renewed if they continue to meet the scholarship criteria. These funds may only be used for in-state tuition at Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne (IPFW). The amount of this scholarship may be affected if other types of tuition-only financial assistance are used. Awards require full-time enrollment in fall and spring semesters, with no break in enrollment. The student has up to three academic years (6 semesters) to complete the bachelors degree. This award may be used for summer school. The summer school enrollment does not have to be full-time, and students are not required to enroll in summer school. A cumulative GPA of 3.5 or greater is required for renewal. Grades for renewal are only checked at the end of spring semester each year.

Recommendation Letter

One letter of recommendation from an Ivy Tech Community College faculty or staff member is required to complete the scholarship application process. The person writing the letter of recommendation should be able to discuss the applicant's academic skills and potential in detail, particularly regarding examples of leadership and problem solving. The letter also needs to include the student's name, letter writer's name and contact information (address, telephone number), and the letter writer's relationship to scholarship applicant.

Attach a copy of your official Ivy Tech transcript and a copy of your current semester's course work (if needed).
