

Crossroads Scholarship Information



Ivy Tech Community College Northeast and IPFW are pleased to announce scholarships for Crossroads students. These merit scholarships are awarded annually. Eligibility is not based on financial need. The scholarship committee, comprised of representatives from both Ivy Tech Northeast and IPFW, will select the recipients after a review of the applicant's academic performance, SAT/ACT test scores, letter of recommendation, and career goal statement. You may download a copy of the application form from the website at www.ivytech.edu/fortwayne/apply-now. Then click on the Scholarships link on the left side of the page. Applications are due March 13, 2009. Applicants need one letter of recommendation from a high school guidance counselor or teacher and a career goal essay of not longer than one page. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Ivy Tech Community College-Northeast Crossroads Scholarship

One student will be awarded a full tuition scholarship at Ivy Tech which can be used to earn an associate degree in an area of study for which there is an articulation agreement with Ivy Tech Northeast and IPFW (see website for a complete listing www.ivytech/fortwayne/crossroads). Provided the student maintains a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher and graduates from Ivy Tech with a 3.5 or higher GPA, the student will be granted a scholarship by IPFW for the remaining academic experience toward earning a bachelors degree.



The criteria to earn the Ivy Tech scholarship:

The student must plan to enroll in an Ivy Tech-IPFW articulated program.

Student has up to three academic years to complete the associates degree.

Student must maintain a 3.2 GPA (first-year) and 3.5 cumulative GPA in subsequent years, GPA calculation to be made at the end of spring semester each year.

Student must maintain full-time status (12 credit hours minimum fall/spring semesters) during each academic year.

Scholarship is available to new students (freshmen) who are attending Ivy Tech for the first time and intend to earn a bachelor's degree at IPFW (students who earned concurrent credit while in high school are eligible to apply).

It is understood that courses eligible for the scholarship are for traditional on-campus courses.

The scholarship award is for in-state resident rate tuition only. Other tuition-only awards for which the student may be eligible will be applied to the tuition funding formula first, with the balance of the tuition paid by this Crossroads scholarship.
