- ¹ Ivy Tech's graduation requirements are not the same as IPFW's requirements for Admission to Teacher Education in IPFW's. Among other requirements, students will have to: a) Pass all portions of the PPST at the minimum scores of 176 (Reading), 172 (Writing), and 175 (Math); b) Complete at least 45 credit hours with a minimum **2.50** cumulative GPA including all course work from previously attending institutions; and c) Earn a **3.0 or better** in each of the following courses at Ivy Tech: ENGL 111, ENGL 112, COMM 101, EDUC 201. You must also earn a **2.0 or better** in MA 101 at IPFW.
