Associate of Science in Early Childhood Education (A.S. in ECE) is designed for students planning to transfer to Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne (IPFW). All courses in the A.S. in ECE program are transferable to IPFW's Bachelor's of Science in Elementary Education with a Concentration in Early Childhood Education. Students enrolled in the A.S. in ECE program at Ivy Tech Community College are required to complete the following sequence of courses.

Among other requirements, students will have to: a) Pass all portions of the PPST at the minimum scores of 176 (Reading), 172 (Writing), and 175 (Math); b) Complete at least 45 credit hours with a minimum **2.50** cumulative GPA including all course work from previously attending institutions; and c) Earn a **B or better** in: ENG W131, COM 114, EDUC W200.
