PERSONAL ENRICHMENT COURSES DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY SERIES

This series of photography courses will help prepare individuals for starting a photography business. Students successfully completing all five courses will receive a certificate of accomplishment from Ivy Tech Community College.

Digital cameras

Bring your digital camera! You will learn how the digital camera works, styles of cameras, camera controls, modes of operation, storage devices and accessories. Location, Kokomo; instructor, Doug Clark. Class meets on Fridays.

Digital photography: editing software

This course will introduce you to the 'Digital Darkroom' using Adobe® Photoshop Elements. Students will learn how to input images into their computer from a camera, memory card, print scanner, or film scanner. Our instructor will show you how to resize, correct color, enhance and print digital images. Students are required to purchase a flash drive/memory stick prior to the start of class. In addition, participants will design and build their own solar energy system. The cost of the solar energy system and all materials are included in the price of the class. Participants also will learn to use a watt meter to gauge the amount of energy appliances and other electrical devices use. Upon completion of the course, participants will be able to keep the watt meter. The system that will be built in class is large enough to charge batteries; however, the knowledge and experience gained in this class has no limits. Course fee includes all supplies.
