IVYCAT THE ONLINE LIBRARY CATALOG

IVYCAT contains the library's print and electronic book titles, print journal titles, and video titles. To get to IvyCat, login on the Campus Connect screen and then click on the Library tab. The Library screen provides two points of access to IvyCat - clicking on the box at the top left, **Virtual Library – Start**, which takes you to the Virtual Library web page or using the link in the **Library Resources** box in the top middle section.

On the Virtual Library web page, IvyCat is listed in the **Find It** section and allows you to search for titles in all of the Ivy Tech libraries statewide. The search box at the bottom of the web page only allows you to search for titles in the NMC and Lawrence libraries. The link under Library Resources also allows you to search for all titles available statewide.

The initial IvyCat search screen will look like the picture below. It is labeled **Keyword+**, so only **key words** (words that have meaning) should be typed in the search box. Words like a, and, the, of, is, in, for, etc., have no meaning so they should not be typed.

Click on your selection under the ▼ .
All of these looks for all words (and)
Any of these looks for either word (or)
As a phrase looks for both words together

Click on your selection under the ▼ .
All fields of a book's record are listed.
Keyword Anywhere searches all of them;
use it unless you are searching for actual title,
author, etc.

Tan areas below each title = more information:

1. *Title has multiple holdings* – click on title (in blue) to see book's record & who owns a copy.
2. *Library Location: (campus name)* – if only campus that owns title; call number and availability given.
 - a. If it is an Online Book, click on title to access it.

Clicking on a book's title takes you to the book's record:

1. If the book is an electronic resource, the first line links directly to it so that you can read it online.
2. The book's information follows - author, publisher, subject headings, etc.
3. Under the book's record, every library that owns a copy is listed in alphabetical order.
 - a. Each entry shows what collection the book is in, its call number, and availability.

Posting Limits Notes:

1. Results reflect all of the titles located in all of the Ivy Tech libraries.
2. They can be limited to either Indianapolis North Meridian Center or Indianapolis Lawrence Campus.
3. To limit both libraries, hold the CTRL key down while you click on both sites.
4. If you want to exclude online books, select Region 8 (without ebooks).

We don't have a book you want? Request it from another Ivy Tech library through Interlibrary Loan; it should arrive within 3–5 business days.
