Campus Library

The Campus Library is a joint effort between Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana and the Tippecanoe County Public Library. It is a joint-use library providing for the needs of both the general public as well as the students and faculty of the college. The library's collections are based on the needs of each clientele and the library is staffed by both organizations. The library serves as the main library for the college and as a satellite location for the public library. The public library's main location is 627 South Street in Lafayette.

Ivy Tech's Virtual Library

Many of the resources provided by the Ivy Tech library are accessible to students and faculty from the Virtual Library page through Campus Connect at <http://cc.ivytech.edu>. By choosing the Library tab and clicking on the image of the Virtual Library, students and faculty have access from the library or remote sites to all of the electronic resources provided by the college. This includes full text periodical databases, online library catalogs, reference materials and numerous pamphlets and reports. Many of these resources are described in this brochure. Also available through the Virtual Library are collections of Internet links, reviewed by Ivy Tech librarians, covering sites relevant to each Ivy Tech program as well as general subject areas.

Remote Access to Virtual Library Page

Ninety-five percent of the college's resources on the Virtual Library are available from off campus computers via the Internet. Access to the magazine and journal databases and online book collections will require a username and password.

FIND IT: Select resources by subject from arts and humanities to science and technology. Search resource collections of journals, magazines, newspapers, reference sources, eBooks and more. Search IVYJO by title or subject areas to find which magazines, journals, and newspapers are full-text and in which databases they are located. Search IVYCAT and TIPCAT online catalogs. Search IvyLynks and IvyFYI for collections of websites selected by Ivy Tech librarians.

DO IT: Consult our Research Guides for APA/MLA citation information. Check Library Resources for online library forms, news and other resources for faculty and students. Search Other Virtual Libraries and Search Engines and Directories for web resources. Look at the collections of other libraries in Library Catalogs. Try an online Library Tutorial. Submit a research related question online to Ask-An-Ivy Tech Librarian.
