Transfer up to 64 credits Toward IU Bachelor of General Studies

As an Ivy Tech student, you may be able to transfer – and apply – up to 64 credits toward an Indiana University Bachelor of General Studies (120 credits).

General studies is a multidisciplinary degree program. It gives you a well-rounded education in arts and humanities, science and mathematics, and social and behavioral sciences, making you competitive in many job markets. A 2002 U.S. Census Bureau report shows what a difference having a bachelor's degree can make: Over an adult's working life, high school graduates can expect to earn an average of \$1.2 million. Adults with a bachelor's degree earn \$2.1 million.

In addition, the general studies degree can help prepare you for graduate or professional school. More than 40 percent of B.G.S. alumni continue their studies. Of those, more than 80 percent complete an advanced degree.

As a general studies student, you can:

- transfer credits – or take additional courses – from an accredited four-year institution.
- supplement credits you earn from your course work with credits for exams and military or life experience.
- pursue a minor, or concentrate in a field that best suits your professional and academic needs.
- add to your credentials by earning an online IU certificate in a variety of fields.

You can complete your degree online, on the IU campus nearest you, or through a combination of online and on-campus study.

KCTCS Academic Transfer Scholarship

Students who are transferring to the University of Louisville directly from a KCTCS institution or Ivy Tech Community College, Sellersburg may be eligible to apply for the KCTCS Academic Transfer Scholarship.

In order to apply, students must:

- Have 40 or more transferable hours at the end of the spring semester. The 40 transferable hours cannot include developmental or technical coursework.
- Have a 3.25 transferable GPA at the end of the spring semester. The transferable GPA cannot include developmental or technical coursework.
- Plan to enter the University of Louisville for the Summer or Fall semester.
- Complete an application for admission to the University of Louisville by March 15.

- Complete a University of Louisville KCTCS Academic Transfer Scholarship Application by March 15.
- Turn in final transcripts by May 30.

Students may apply if they currently do not have a 3.25 transferable GPA or 40 transferable hours but anticipate they will at the end of the Spring semester. Awards are based on the funds available.

Ivy Tech Community College and Indiana State University have formed a [DegreeLink Partnership](#) that enables students to transfer their Ivy Tech associate degree and complete selected ISU bachelor degrees—via distance learning. In addition, transfer agreements ensure maximum transfer of Ivy Tech credit to more than 100 majors offered on the ISU campus.

Indiana State is a medium-sized university founded in 1865. The student population of approximately 10,000 includes students from throughout the United States and 59 countries. The University has offered distance learning since 1969.



Bachelor degree-completion programs offered via distance learning include:

Saint Mary-of-the-Woods College

Ivy Tech Community College and Saint Mary-of-the-Woods College (SMWC) signed 29 statewide transfer agreements involving 11 associate's degree programs offered through Ivy Tech and 16 bachelor's degree programs at SMWC. These new transfer agreements, referred to as "2+2 agreements," will allow students to attend their first two years of college at Ivy Tech to earn an Associate of Science degree, then transfer into a specific campus-based or distance education bachelor's degree program at SMWC as a junior.

Ivy Tech Grants

- Saint Mary-of-the-Woods College will provide **Ivy Tech Grants** to qualifying students who graduate from Ivy Tech Community College and enroll in either SMWC's campus-based program or SMWC's Woods External Degree (WED) Program.
- Ivy Tech graduates are automatically awarded the Ivy Tech scholarship to be applied toward the cost of tuition when they are reviewed for admission. No separate application is required.
- Students who graduated from Ivy Tech Community College since 2006 qualify for the grant.
- Students might also qualify for need-based financial aid.
