Transfer Credit Policy

NOTE: THE FINAL TRANSFERABILITY OF ANY COURSES TO THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN INDIANA WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE ACADEMIC ADVISORS WITHIN THE COLLEGE OF THE MAJOR AT THE TIME OF MATRICULATION. THIS INFORMATION IS MEANT TO BE USED ONLY AS A GUIDELINE AND IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE.

Only course credit earned from accredited universities (contact the Office of the Registrar to determine if a school is accredited) can be accepted as transfer credit to USI subject to the following guidelines:

1. As of spring 2000, USI will only accept grades of "C" (2.0) or better regardless of GPA.
2. A maximum of 64 credit hours may be transferred from regionally accredited community and/or junior colleges.
3. Orientation courses are not accepted as transfer credit.
4. Noncredit and audited courses do not transfer to USI.
5. Remedial courses (normally course numbers of below 100) will not be accepted as transfer credit.
6. Courses taken in programs not offered by USI do not transfer.
7. Even though credit hours are transferable to USI, the transferred hours may not necessarily apply toward a particular degree program. The applicability of credits toward a particular degree can be determined in counsel with the appropriate departmental advisor.
