



## Scholarship Opportunities

### **Academic Scholarship - \$1000.00**

Each year, Ivy Tech Community College awards 15 non-need based Academic Scholarships to high school seniors from Clay, Greene, Parke, Putnam, Sullivan, Vermillion and Vigo counties in Indiana and Clark, Crawford and Edgar counties in Illinois. The value of the scholarship is \$2,000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: be a high school senior with a minimum of a 3.0/4.0 cumulative grade point average; be ranked in the upper half of his/her graduating class; maintain a minimum 2.75 college grade point average to remain eligible.

### **B & S Plumbing Scholarship - \$500.00**

The B & S Plumbing Scholarship was established as a result of Ivy Tech Foundation's golf tournament. The value of the scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have a minimum 3.0 grade point average; be currently enrolled in a degree program; have completed the admissions process; be enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours per semester.

### **Bemis Company Scholarship - 1/2 Tuition, 1/2 Books Annually**

Through a generous donation to Ivy Tech Foundation, Bemis Company, Inc. provides annual scholarships that provide 1/2 the cost of tuition and books. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have a minimum 2.0 grade point average; be in one of the following programs: Graphic Design, Media Design, Visual Communications, Industrial Electronics, Advanced Manufacturing or any industrial related program.

### **Beth Turner Memorial Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Beth Turner Memorial Scholarship is established by the Family of Elizabeth "Beth" Turner to honor her life. The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage students of need to pursue their educational goals.

### **C. Huston Isaacs Scholarship - \$500.00**

The C. Huston Isaacs Scholarship is presented each year because of the generosity and support of C. Huston Isaacs and his family. Mr. Isaacs was the Wabash Valley Region's first dean and director. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have a minimum 3.0 grade point average; be currently enrolled in a degree program; have completed the admissions process; be enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours per semester

### **Career & Technical Scholarship - \$2,000.00**

Each year, Ivy Tech Community College awards 10 non-need based vocational scholarships to high school seniors from Clay, Greene, Parke, Putnam, Sullivan, Vermillion and Vigo counties in Indiana and Clark, Crawford and Edgar counties in Illinois. The value of the scholarship is \$2,000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for his scholarship, the student must: be enrolled in a vocational education program; have a minimum of a 3.0/4.0 cumulative grade point average in vocational education courses and a minimum of a 2.0/4.0 cumulative grade point average in all other courses; maintain a minimum 2.0 college grade point average once enrolled at Ivy Tech.

### **Carmichael Farm Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Carmichael Farm Scholarship was established as a result of Ivy Tech Foundation's golf tournament. The value of the scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester) to assist with tuition, books and/or fees. Scholarship eligibility: preference to Sullivan County incoming freshman entering Agriculture program.

### **Chancellor's Award Scholarship - Full Tuition, Books, & Fees up to Four (4) Semesters**

The Chancellor's Award is available for high-achieving high school seniors from Clay, Greene, Parke, Putnam, Sullivan, Vermillion and Vigo counties in Indiana and Clark, Crawford and Edgar counties in Illinois seeking to begin their college education at Ivy Tech Community College. It is to be used for the cost of in-state tuition, as a stipend toward the cost of books and to pay the technology fee for four semesters (to be disbursed fall and spring semesters). Applications for this award must be submitted by March 10. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: be ranked in the top 10% of his/her graduating class or have a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale; maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average once enrolled at Ivy Tech to remain eligible.

### **Clara Fairbanks Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Clara Fairbanks Scholarship was established through the generous support of the Clara Fairbanks Foundation, Inc. in 2005. The value of the scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: be a resident of Vigo county or surrounding counties; be currently enrolled in one of the following programs: Environmental Design, Visual Communications, any business program, any health sciences program, Early Childhood Education or Human Services; maintain a 2.0 minimum grade point average; be enrolled for a minimum of nine credit hours per semester. Preference is given to female students who can demonstrate financial need.

### **Crown Electric Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The Crown Electric Scholarship was established as a result of Ivy Tech Foundation's golf tournament and is meant to assist with tuition, books and/or fees. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: be enrolled in six credit hours at Ivy Tech and have a minimum 3.0 grade point average; be pursuing an Electrical or related Industrial degree. Preference will be given to students who want to become electricians or are obtaining a degree in a related trade.

### **Donald E. Nelson Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The Donald E. Nelson Scholarship was established to provide educational opportunities to students who demonstrate financial need. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester). Scholarship eligibility: FAFSA and application completion for Ivy Tech; maintain 2.0 minimum grade point average; enrolled in minimum of nine credit hours in a degree program.

### **Duke Energy Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The Duke Energy Scholarship is awarded to a 2nd year student in good standing who demonstrates leadership on campus, in the classroom or through community service. The student should also be willing to participate in a paid internship/co-op with Duke Energy. Scholarship eligibility: maintain a 3.0 or better grade point average; be an electrical or mechanical program major.

### **Eitel Family Scholarship for Entrepreneurship & Civic Engagement - \$500.00**

The Eitel Family Scholarship for Entrepreneurship & Civic Engagements is made available through the generosity of Mr. & Mrs. Kenneth Eitel of Greencastle, Indiana.

### **Ernest & Mary Gripe Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Ernest & Mary Gripe Scholarship provides an award for a student pursuing Nursing at the Greencastle Instructional Site.

### **Esther Reupke Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The Esther Reupke Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Esther Reupke. At the request of the donor, preference will be given to Vigo county students who meet academic and economic qualifications. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have completed a FAFSA and Ivy Tech application; maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average; be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours in a degree program.

### **Eugene Martin & the Class of 1958 Scholarship - \$1,500.00**

The Eugene Martin & Class of 1958 Scholarship is awarded annually to a Linton High School senior who plans to attend Ivy Tech Community College - Wabash Valley. The selection will be made through consultation with Ivy Tech Admission staff and the leadership of Linton High School. The value of the scholarship is \$1,500 (\$750 each semester). Scholarship eligibility: be enrolled in a minimum of nine credit hours per semester.

### **First Financial Bank Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The First Financial Bank Scholarship was established as a result of the First Financial Bank Scholarship Scramble and the Scholarship Cruisin' Car Show. Each year, Ivy Tech awards nineteen \$1,000 (\$500 each semester) scholarships. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have completed FAFSA and an Ivy Tech application; have a minimum 3.0 grade point average in high school or a post-secondary institution; be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester in a degree program.

### **Frances & Harry Price Scholarship - \$250.00**

Through their commitment, leadership and partnership in our community, Mr. & Mrs. Patrick Ralston have created a wonderful scholarship opportunity in honor of Harry and Frances Price.

Patrick and Nancy Ralston established the Harry and Frances Price Scholarship to provide much needed educational opportunities to Wabash Valley students pursuing higher education at Ivy Tech in memory of Nancy's father and lifetime educator, Harry Price and his wife Frances.

### **Gary Wright - I.B.E.W. Local Union #725 Memorial Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Gary Wright - I.B.E.W. Local Union #725 Memorial Scholarship fund was established by the I.B.E.W. membership in memory of Gary Wright, who was killed in a tragic accident in Terre Haute. The value of the scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, students must be Ivy Tech - Wabash Valley students who are I.B.E.W. members or their immediate family members. To qualify a student should have a minimum 2.0 grade point average. Applicants are also asked to complete a one and a half page essay titled "How Organized Labor has Affected Society in the Last 100 Years."

### **Gerrith E. May Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The Gerrith E. May Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Gerrith E. May, former president of Wabash Valley Hydraulic Service Center, Inc. in Terre Haute and is awarded annually. Mr. May thought that education was very important and encouraged young people around him in that pursuit. In 1978 Mr. May started his business in his garage with his brother Jim. It then moved into a building that sits behind the existing business today. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: be a 2nd year student in a manufacturing degree program; be enrolled in a minimum of nine credit hours; have a minimum 2.0 grade point average.

### **Graffis Medical Career Scholarship - \$1,300.00**

The Graffis Medical Career Scholarship is made available through the generosity of Dr. & Mrs. Thomas Graffis of Greencastle, Indiana. The scholarship will be awarded to a Health Careers Student at the Greencastle campus who resides in Putnam County.

### **Graphic Arts Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Graphic Arts Scholarship is established through the generous commitment of the Graphic Arts faculty. The scholarship is valued at \$250 and is available to students in the Visual Communications program. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must: have a minimum 2.0 grade point average; be enrolled in the Visual Communications program; be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.

### **Greencastle Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Greencastle Scholarship was established through the generous support of the Changing Lives...Building Futures campaign to establish scholarship funds for students attending the Greencastle Campus. It is valued at \$500 and eligibility requirements are that the student: have a minimum 2.0 grade point average; be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.

### **Hamilton Center Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Hamilton Center, Inc. Scholarship was established as a result of Ivy Tech Foundation's golf tournament. It is given annually to a student enrolled in Early Childhood Education or Health Care to assist with tuition, books and/or fees. It is valued at \$500 (\$250 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have completed FAFSA and the Ivy Tech application; have a minimum 2.5 grade point average; be enrolled in six credit hours.

### **Hannig Memorial Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Hannig Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Mark Shelton Hannig, son of Mr. and Mrs. Shelton Hannig. It is given annually and is valued at \$500. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must: have completed FAFSA and the Ivy Tech application; have a minimum 3.0 grade point average in high school or a post-secondary institution; be enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours each semester in a degree program.

### **Harvey S. Poling Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

This scholarship was established as a tribute to a veteran teacher and Ivy Tech Community College administrator, Harvey S. Poling Jr. It is available to assist with tuition, books, fees and expenses. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have completed the FAFSA; be at least 28 years old; have a minimum 3.0 grade point average; have completed half of his/her program requirements.

### **Herbert Refkin Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Herbert Refkin Scholarship was established to assist Automotive program students with tuition, books and/or fees. The value of the scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester). Eligibility requirements: have a minimum 3.0 grade point average; be enrolled in the Automotive program; be enrolled in nine credit hours.

### **Labor Hall of Fame Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Labor Hall of Fame Scholarship was established to support students in apprenticeship programs. It is valued at \$500 (\$250 each semester). Eligibility: have a minimum 2.0 grade point average; be in an apprenticeship program.

### **Larry Lowey Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The Larry Lowey Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Larry Lowey. At the request of the donor, the scholarship is to be awarded to a student currently enrolled in the Electronics and Computer Technology program to assist with tuition, books and/or fees. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have a minimum 2.5 grade point average; be enrolled in six credit hours; be enrolled in the Electronics and Computer Technology program.

### **Liberal Arts Scholarship - \$500.00**

Eligible applicants will demonstrate financial need and be enrolled in a Liberal Arts Program. Student should be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours of Liberal Arts related coursework during semester and be a Liberal Arts declared major.

### **LTL General Scholarship - \$350.00**

The LTL General Scholarship was established by Louise T. Lamkin, wife of Gerald Lamkin, the past president of Ivy Tech Community College. It is intended to recognize the value of an Ivy Tech Community College education and be a catalyst in inspiring others to donate funds to assist Ivy Tech students in pursuing their educational goals. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have completed the FAFSA and the Ivy Tech application; have a minimum 3.0 ("B") grade point average in high school or a post-secondary institution; be enrolled in a degree program; be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours per semester.

### **MedLab Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The MedLab Scholarship was established as a result of Ivy Tech Foundation's golf tournament. It is intended for tuition and books only. The scholarship recipient must be an immediate family member or employee of MedLab. (This includes unmarried children or spouse.) The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester). If the recipient receives other awards, the amount of this scholarship will be adjusted. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: be an employee or immediate family member of MedLab; be enrolled in six credit hours.

### **Michael Stolfe Memorial Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Michael Stolfe Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Michael Stolfe, a long-time, outstanding faculty member in Design Technology at Ivy Tech Community College -Wabash Valley. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must: have completed FAFSA and the Ivy Tech application; have a minimum 3.0 ("B") grade point average in high school or a post-secondary institution; be enrolled in Design Technology; be enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours per semester.

### **North Central High School Scholarship - \$500.00**

Each year, an anonymous gift provides a scholarship opportunity for a North Central High School student to begin coursework at Ivy Tech Community College. The Dollars for Scholars initiative narrows candidates to two and Ivy Tech makes the final selection. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have a minimum 2.5 grade point average; be a full-time student enrolled at the Ivy Tech Terre Haute campus or an extension site (such as Sullivan) in the fall semester immediately after their high school graduation; be enrolled in a degree program or be a transfer student.

### **Oakley Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

The Oakley Foundation Endowed Scholarship was established to assist students who demonstrate financial need while attending Ivy Tech Community College - Wabash Valley. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester) for up to two recipients. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have completed FAFSA and the Ivy Tech application; have a minimum 2.0 grade point average; be enrolled in a minimum of nine credit hours in a degree program.

### **Poling Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

This scholarship was established as a tribute to Harvey S. Poling Jr, a veteran teacher and Ivy Tech Community College administrator. It is intended to assist students with tuition, books, fees and expenses. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, students must: have completed FAFSA and the Ivy Tech application; be at least 28 years old; have a minimum 3.0 grade point average; have completed half of their program requirements.

### **Practical Nursing Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

Eligible applicants will be enrolled in Practical Nursing program.

### **Ralph G. & Mary L. Barkley Scholarship - \$1,000.00**

"The Ralph G. & Mary L. Barkley scholarship was established to provide educational opportunities to students who demonstrate financial need, a positive attitude and good work ethic. It is intended for tuition and books only, and the number of scholarships given are to be divided equally between males and females. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for a scholarship, the student must: have a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average; be in one of the following programs: Electronics, Nursing or Office Administration; be willing to provide a Drug Affidavit.

### **Staff Senate Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Staff Senate Scholarship was established by the Ivy Tech- Wabash Valley Staff Senate group to assist with the cost of books and with technology fees for Ivy Tech support staff furthering their education at the College. Consideration of selection will be in the following order: Hourly Staff employee (full-time or part-time), immediate family member (dependent or spouse) of Hourly Staff full-time or part-time employee. If the scholarship is not applied for by either of these groups, it may be awarded to a general student applicant enrolled in 12 contact hours and meeting the academic requirements. The annual award is valued at \$250. Scholarship eligibility: must be enrolled in at least six credit hours during the semester of request; have a minimum 2.0 grade point average.

### **Teachers Credit Union Scholarship - \$2,930.00**

The Teachers Credit Union established this annual scholarship throughout the State of Indiana for its locations within an Ivy Tech service area. The value of the scholarship is \$2930 (\$1465 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have financial need; be a resident of Putnam County; have a minimum 3.0 grade point average; be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.

**Terre Haute Regional Hospital - \$1,000.00**

This scholarship is for health-related programs.

**Terre Haute Savings Bank Scholarship - \$500.00**

The Terre Haute Savings Bank Scholarship program was established to encourage dislocated workers, women returning to the workforce, minorities and persons receiving public assistance to enroll or return to school. The goal is to enhance opportunities for economic self-sufficiency through post-secondary education. Through the generosity of Terre Haute Savings Bank, \$500 scholarships will be awarded each year to students enrolling at Ivy Tech Community College -Wabash Valley. Scholarship eligibility: be a dislocated worker, woman returning to the workforce, minority or a student currently receiving public assistance. The priority order for awards will be: 1. Students enrolling at Ivy Tech for the first time, 2. Students not currently receiving other financial aid and 3. Part-time students.

**William & Judith Brett Scholarship - \$400.00**

The Brett Scholarship was established by Judith and William Brett to assist students currently enrolled in the Radiologic Technology (Imaging Sciences) program. This scholarship is valued at \$250 and is to be used to cover the cost of tuition, required books and other class-related materials. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: have completed FAFSA and the Ivy Tech application; have a minimum 2.0 grade point average; be currently enrolled in the Radiologic Technology (Imaging Sciences) degree program; be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours; be a displaced worker; be married with children and able to demonstrate family financial need.
