**ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE (AS) DEGREE**

Two-year Associate of Science programs typically contain 40 percent or more general education, with the balance in technical and profession courses. **ELEMENTARY**

The degree allows graduates to apply to teacher education programs at four-year institutions to pursue bachelor's degrees in Elementary education, grades K- 6.
