

NURSING (ASN)

The Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) program is designed to accommodate two groups of students: those who are entering a nursing program for the first time and those Licensed Practical Nurses or certified Paramedics seeking educational mobility to the associate degree level. As a graduate of the ASN Program, you will be eligible to apply to take the NCLEX-RN examination to become a Registered Nurse. You may seek immediate employment as a Nurse or choose to transfer your credits to a four-year institution offering a baccalaureate degree.

The Nursing program is a selective admission program. When you apply to the College, you will be accepted into Healthcare Support with a concentration in Nursing while you complete the prerequisite requirements. The Nursing program accepts a limited number of students each year, and there is a separate application process. Please contact your program advisor for more information.
