

APPOINTMENT OF WILLIAM D. KRAMER AS VICE PRESIDENT EMERITUS

WHEREAS, Dr. William D. Kramer has spent more than thirty years in service to Indiana higher education, and has served Ivy Tech Community College with distinction for more than two decades and more than fifteen years as Vice President of Planning and Education; and

WHEREAS, as the chief academic officer, Dr. Kramer tirelessly led efforts to improve and expand the College's academic programs; to raise standards, expectations, and compensation for the Ivy Tech faculty; and to improve the educational experiences of every Ivy Tech student; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kramer has represented the College with other Indiana colleges and universities and has been instrumental in establishing and promoting the level of transfer that Ivy Tech students now enjoy; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kramer has worked together with the Ivy Tech community to make significant contributions to the growth and development of the College, which is reflected by the more than doubling of enrollment, the approval of over 600 new associate degree and certificate programs, and the expansion of services for students during his tenure as Vice President of Planning and Education; and

WHEREAS, under Dr. Kramer's statewide leadership for facilities planning, the College has benefited from over \$350 million in major capital projects; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Kramer has elected to retire from the College;


