

**AUTHORIZATION TO ACQUIRE THE HOLMAN ELEMENTRAY SCHOOL IN
PERU, REGION 5**

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2006-5

WHEREAS, the College has been leasing space at the Grissom complex, near Peru, to provide classes, testing, advising, and enrollment services, and

WHEREAS, the College has a continuing commitment to the delivery of said services to the city of Peru and Miami County, and

WHEREAS, the Peru Community Schools has offered to donate the Holman Elementary School to the College, and


WHEREAS, said school building has been evaluated by an architect, engineer, and construction manager for use as an instructional center and, with a proscribed amount of renovation, found to be acceptable, and

WHEREAS, the Region 5 Board of Trustees has requested that the State Trustees acquire said property;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Trustees do hereby approve the acquisition of the Holman Elementary School at 425 West Main Street in Peru as a donation from the Peru Community Schools, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Trustees do hereby authorize and direct the President and any other appropriate College Officer to enter into said acquisition of said property, after the documents have been approved by the College Interim General Counsel.
