

**ACCEPTANCE OF IPFW'S OFFER TO PROVIDE POLICE SERVICES  
FOR FORT WAYNE CAMPUSES, REGION 3/NORTHEAST**

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 2010-3**

**WHEREAS**, Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana does not have a police force, and

**WHEREAS**, the main campus of Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne (IPFW) is located in very close proximity to both of the College's Fort Wayne campuses, and

**WHEREAS**, IPFW has a police force and has offered to provide police related services for the College's Fort Wayne campuses, including but not limited to patrolling both campuses and responding to requests for police assistance, at no cost to the College, and

**WHEREAS**, College administrators in Fort Wayne have evaluated IPFW's offer and recommended to the Regional Board that the College accept IPFW's offer to provide police related services to the College's Fort Wayne campuses, and


**WHEREAS**, the Regional Trustees are responsible for the development of cooperative arrangements with other education entities in the College's Northeast Region and have recommended that the State Trustees: (1) accept IPFW's offer to provide police related services to the College's Fort Wayne campuses at no cost to the College, and (2) authorize IPFW police officers to come onto the College's Fort Wayne campuses to provide those services, and

**WHEREAS**, under IC 21-27-6-2, the ultimate responsibility for the management and policies of the College, including its administrative regions, rests with the College's State Board of Trustees;


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the State Trustees accept IPFW's offer to provide police related services to the College's Fort Wayne campuses at no cost to the College and authorize IPFW police officers to come onto the College's Fort Wayne campuses to provide those services, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the State Trustees authorize and direct the President of the College and any other appropriate, designated College employee to execute any documents related to the implementation of this resolution, after the documents have been approved by the College General Counsel.
