WHEREAS, the development of best practices can help the College increase efficiency and promote student success, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Ivy Tech Board of Trustees hereby creates a board and management committee to determine current best practice and to streamline said best practices, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Ivy Tech Board of Trustees appoint Les Shively to chair this "Best Practice" committee, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Ivy Tech Board of Trustees asks the President to appoint members of the leadership team, regional and state, to serve on this committee, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the charge of the "Best Practice" committee should focus on core business functions which support recruitment, remediation, retention and reengineering, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, the "Best Practice" committee shall periodically present progress reports to the Ivy Tech State Board of Trustees.
