

**APPROVAL OF A CONTRACT TO RENOVATE THE NORTH MERIDIAN CENTER
BUILDING IN INDIANAPOLIS TO UPDATE TECHNOLOGY CABLING
INFRASTRUCTURE, REGION 8/CENTRAL INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the North Meridian Center building on the main campus in Indianapolis is in need of new Ethernet cabling to support the technology of the building's users, and

WHEREAS, the bid process has been completed in accordance with applicable statutes, Indiana Case Law and College procedures including State Trustee requirements, and


WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid according to College procedures is from ERMCO, Inc. for \$648,010, which requires approval by the State Trustees, causing the total project costs to be \$797,510 including the rewiring contract, demolition, architectural fees, bidding costs, and contingency, and

WHEREAS, the Region 8/ Central Indiana Board of Trustees and the College Office of Information Technology has reviewed the project and made a recommendation on a contract award;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Trustees do hereby approve a contract award to ERMCO, Inc. for \$648,010.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Trustees do hereby authorize and direct the President and any other appropriate, designated College employee to negotiate and execute a contract with said firm after the documents have been approved by the College General Counsel.
