

**Resolution Honoring the Leadership of Daniel L. Schenk**

**Resolution 2014-15**

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Schenk, joined the Ivy Tech Community College team 37 years ago

**WHEREAS**, since 1990 Daniel Schenk has served as the Chancellor of the Southwest region which encompasses ten counties in southern Indiana and locations in Evansville, Princeton, and Tell City

**WHEREAS**, He was instrumental in securing state funding for a \$38,000,000 campus expansion and renovation project, making Evansville one of the largest facilities in the Ivy Tech system

**WHEREAS**, Under his leadership enrollment in the Southwest Region has grown by almost 300%, from 2,202 students to over 8,400 students, and the annual number of degrees and certificates awarded has increased from 277 to 1,345

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Schenk has led the Region's efforts in many innovative initiatives including the development of the first statewide transfer program with a local university

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Schenk has been a key member of efforts which led to the signing of a Letter of Intent among local educational partners for the new Indiana University Medical School


**WHEREAS**, His continued support of local partnerships led to the Southwest Region being the inaugural host site for an early college program with the Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation

**WHEREAS**, His leadership of the President's Executive Council, statewide Facilities and Design Council and one of the College's first strategic planning efforts as well as his many community leadership roles, further demonstrate his commitment to the growth of Ivy Tech and to student success
