Success on NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN Licensure Examinations

Jan. 1, 2016 – Dec. 31, 2016

- Definition: Percentage of graduate first time test takers who pass the National Council Licensure Exam (NCLEX) for RN and PN as reported by the Indiana State Board of Nursing:
- School of Nursing Expected Level of Achievement:
 - The program's annual and 3-year average NCLEX-RN/PN pass rates will meet or exceed accrediting organization standards.
- Actual Levels of Achievement:
 - Statewide Aggregate ASN Program Pass Rate Average (all program tracks): **85.3%**
 - ASN Traditional Program: **84.9%**
 - LPN to ASN Transition Program: **86.2%**
 - Paramedic to ASN Transition Program: **100%**
 - Statewide Aggregate PN Program Pass Rate Average: **96.8%**

Program Completion Rates

2016-2017 Academic Year

- School of Nursing Expected Levels of Achievement:
 - 70% of ASN Traditional, LPN to ASN Transition, and Paramedic to ASN Transition students will graduate within 6 semesters, beginning with enrollment in the first nursing (NRSG) course, not including periods of non-continuous enrollment.
 - 70% of PN students will graduate within 4.5 semesters, beginning with enrollment in the first nursing (NRSG) course, not including periods of non-continuous enrollment.
- Actual Levels of Achievement:
 - ASN Traditional Program: **87.1%**
 - LPN to ASN Transition Program: **91.2%**
 - Paramedic to ASN Transition Program: **86.70%**
 - PN Program: **76.16%**

2015-2016 College Completion Rate Formula:

- Based on an institutional six-year (300% time frame) completion rate. Defined as the percentage of first-time degree-seeking students who initially enrolled full-time at Ivy Tech during the fall semester.
 - ASN Program (all program tracks): **86.4%**
 - PN Program: **78.0%**

Employment Rates

2016-2017 Academic Year

- School of Nursing Expected Level of Achievement:
 - 70% of graduate respondents will be employed in nursing or pursuing advanced education within six (6) months following graduation.
- Actual Levels of Achievement:
 - ASN Traditional Program: **80.5%**
 - LPN to ASN Transition Program: **87.5%**
 - Paramedic to ASN Transition Program: **100%**
 - PN Program: **92.9%**
