Scholarship Description

The ECED Scholarship fund will provide students pursuing their educational goals through the Early Childhood Education (ECED) program at Ivy Tech Community College. The funds will be apportioned to cover costs associated with ECED tuition and fees linked to courses included in the CDA process certification, other ECED certifications, and ECED degree at Ivy Tech. Preference is given to students who do not currently receive financial aid and have maintained a 2.5 GPA or greater.

The AART Scholarship fund provides financial assistance to Advanced Automation and Robotics Technology (AART) students pursuing their educational goals at Ivy Tech Community College.

To be eligible for this award, students must:

- Be enrolled in the AART program through the Wabash Valley Region
- Be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours
- Be meeting or exceeding Standard of Academic progress.

The Wabash Valley American Gas Association scholarship provides scholarship opportunities to students pursuing an associate's degree or certificate in Welding, Pipefitting, HVAC, Gas Utility, Mechanical Engineering, Petroleum Engineering, Chemical Engineering or Engineering Technologies. The scholarship was established to assist students defray the costs of tuition, fees, books, tools, required instructional supplies and other eligible expenses.

This \$3000 scholarship will be awarded to two recipients as follows: the spring semester of the recipients; first year and the fall and spring semesters of the recipients; second year in the amount of \$1000 per semester.

To be eligible for this award students must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled full-time or part-time student in the two-year or certificate program in Welding, Pipefitting, HVAC, Gas Utility, Mechanical Engineering, Petroleum Engineering, Chemical Engineering or Engineering Technologies ;
- Have successfully completed one semester of study;
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher in the semester prior to distribution;
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours; and
- Have not been a recipient of this scholarship in prior semester(s).

The Wabash Valley ASN Scholarship was established to provide scholarship opportunities to students seeking an associate's degree in Nursing. The value of this scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

be enrolled in the nursing's associate's degree program, and
be degree-seeking through the Terre Haute campus.

The B & S Plumbing Scholarship was established as a result of Ivy Tech Foundation's golf tournament. The value of the scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

have a minimum 3.0 grade point average,
be currently enrolled in a degree program, and
be enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours per semester.

Through a generous donation from Bemis Company, Inc., the Wabash Valley Bemis Company Scholarship provides annual scholarships that provide 1/2 of the cost of tuition and books up to \$1000 per semester.

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

have a minimum 2.0 grade point average, and
be degree-seeking in one of the following programs through the Terre Haute campus.

Graphic Design, Media Design, Visual Communication, Industrial Electronics, Advanced Manufacturing, or Any industrial-related program.

The Brent Foltz Memorial Fund provides book scholarship opportunities to students participating in the Plumbers & Steamfitters Local 157 Apprenticeship training program.

To be eligible, recipients must be in their initial year of the apprenticeship program. Preference is given to Vigo County residents that have graduated within the last five years.

The C. Huston Isaacs Scholarship is presented each year because of the generosity and support of C. Huston Isaacs and his family. Mr. Isaacs was the Wabash Valley Region's first dean and director. A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to one (1) recipient.

To be eligible for this scholarship, students must:

have a minimum 3.0 grade point average (GPA),
be enrolled in a degree program, and
be enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours.

The Carmichael Farm Scholarship is for \$500 (\$250 each semester) to assist with tuition, books and/or fees; Preference is given to Sullivan County residents who are incoming freshman & enrolled in the Agriculture program.

The Wabash Valley Clabber Girl Scholarship is directed toward students interested in pursuing a career in agriculture, veterinary science, hospitality management or culinary arts related fields. This \$500 scholarship is awarded to a student in good standing who demonstrates financial need.

Recipient requirements include:

possess a minimum 3.0 grade point average in high school or post-secondary education

enrolled in at least six (6) credit hours and

enrolled in the agriculture, hospitality management or culinary program.

Preference is given to Wabash Valley Region students followed by students of the Indianapolis Region.

The Clara Fairbanks Scholarship was established through the generous support of the Clara Fairbanks Foundation, Inc. in 2005. The value of the scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must be a resident of Vigo county
maintain a 2.0 minimum grade point average
enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours per semester, and
enrolled in one of the following programs
Environmental Design,
Visual Communications,
any business program,
any health sciences program,
Early Childhood Education,
Human Services.

Preference given to female students who can demonstrate financial need.

The Crown Electric Scholarship is for \$1000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: -be enrolled in six credit hours at Ivy Tech and have a minimum 3.0 grade point average -be pursuing an Electrical or related Industrial degree. Preference will be given to students who want to become electricians or are obtaining a degree in a related trade.

The Donald E. Nelson Scholarship was established to provide educational opportunities to students who demonstrate financial need. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship, the recipient must:

Have completed a FAFSA for the current year;
Maintain 2.0 minimum grade point average;
Be a degree-seeking student; and
Be enrolled in minimum of six credit hours.

The Esther Reupke Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Esther Reupke. At the request of the donor, preference will be given to Vigo county students who meet academic and economic qualifications. The value of the scholarship is \$1000/\$500 semester.

To be eligible for this scholarship, students must:

complete the FAFSA,
complete the Ivy Tech scholarship application,
maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average,
be a degree-seeking student, and
enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.

The Eugene Martin & Class of 1958 Scholarship is awarded annually to a Linton High School senior who plans to attend Ivy Tech Community College - Wabash Valley. The selection will be made through consultation with Ivy Tech Admission staff and the leadership of Linton High School. The value of the scholarship is \$3,000 (\$1,500 each semester). Scholarship eligibility: be enrolled in a minimum of nine credit hours per semester.

The Wabash Valley Farm Credit Mid America Agricultural Scholarship was established to provide assistance to agriculture students. This \$500 scholarship will be split between the fall and spring semesters, \$250 per semester.

To be eligible for this scholarship, the recipient must:

Be pursuing an Agriculture degree through the Terre Haute Campus
Be enrolled in at least six (6) credit hours, and
Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.

The First Financial Bank Scholarship was established as a result of the First Financial Bank Scholarship Scramble and Annual Car Show. The value of this scholarship is \$1,000 (\$500 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

have completed the current year's FAFSA,
have a minimum 3.0 grade point average in high school or a post-secondary institution,
be a degree-seeking student, and
enroll in at least 12 credit hours each semester.

The Frances & Harry Price Scholarship was established by Patrick & Nancy Ralston in memory of Frances & Harry Price. Mr. Price was an educator in Vigo County for many years and this annual award is to honor Mr. & Mrs. Price.

The Futures Unlimited Scholarship has been established to support students of promise and need. Priority given to minority groups, women and displaced workers.

Parke County Learning Center Student additional criteria to be established

The Gary Wright - I.B.E.W. Local Union #725 Memorial Scholarship fund was established by the I.B.E.W. membership in memory of Gary Wright, who was killed in a tragic accident in Terre Haute. The value of the scholarship is \$1,000 (\$500 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship, students must:

Be Ivy Tech Wabash Valley students who are I.B.E.W. members or their immediate family members, and
Maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average.

The Gerrith E. May Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Gerrith E. May, former president of Wabash Valley Hydraulic Service Center, Inc. in Terre Haute and is awarded annually. Mr. May thought that education was very important and encouraged young people around him in that pursuit. In 1978 Mr. May started his business in his garage with his brother Jim. It then moved into a building that sits behind the existing business today. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester). To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: -be a 2nd year student in a manufacturing degree program -be enrolled in a minimum of nine credit hours -have a minimum 2.0 grade point average.

The Graphic Arts Scholarship is established through the generous commitment of the Graphic Arts faculty. The scholarship is valued at \$250 and is available to students in the Visual Communications program. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must: -have a minimum 2.0 grade point average -be enrolled in the Visual Communications program -be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.

The Hamilton Center, Inc. Scholarship is given annually to a student enrolled in Early Childhood Education, Human Services or a health-related program to assist with tuition, books and/or fees. It is valued at \$500 (\$250 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must;

have completed the FAFSA,

maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average,

and be enrolled in minimum of six credit hours.

The Hannig Memorial Scholarship is given annually and is valued at \$500. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must: - have completed FAFSA -have a minimum 3.0 grade point average in high school or a post-secondary institution -be enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours each semester in a degree program.

This scholarship, held by the Ivy Tech Foundation, is established as a tribute to a veteran teacher and Ivy Tech administrator, Harvey S. Poling, Jr. to allow students in need to continue and finish their education in a timely fashion.

Eligibility criteria, student must:

be at least 28 years of age,
have completed at least one-half of the program of study,
have a minimum 3.0 GPA,
have a financial need, and
have completed a current FAFSA.

The Herbert Refkin Scholarship was established to assist Automotive students with tuition, books and/or fees. The value of the scholarship is \$500 (\$250 each semester). To be eligible, the recipient must have been enrolled in the Automotive program and enrolled in six credit hours.

The Ivy Tech Scholarship fund was established from unrestricted giving to the Wabash Valley Region. Awards vary from \$200 - \$1,500 per year depending on funding availability.

The Joshua T. Thompson Memorial Endowed Scholarship was established by Steven and Emily Walton in memory of their nephew, Joshua, to provide assistance to Wabash Valley students who are enrolled in welding or industrial technology programs. During the selection process, preference will be given to Sullivan County students. This scholarship is to be used to cover the cost of tuition, required books and other class-related materials.

Scholarship requirements:

Scholarship is to be used for students at the Terre Haute Campus.

Recipient should be from Sullivan County. If no one is eligible from Sullivan then students from surrounding counties (Greene, Clay, Vigo, Knox) should be considered. If there is an exceptional candidate from a surrounding county they should be included in the pool along with Sullivan County residents.

Recipients should be a welding student or in an Industrial Technology program that includes welding classwork. The student should be striving for a completion of certification or a degree.

Part-time or full-time students will be considered.

A student is getting tuition from their workplace or from the State of Indiana is not eligible for the scholarship. The scholarship will be given to one student for a school year with the award split between two semesters

The Larry Lowey Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Larry Lowey. At the request of the donor, the scholarship is to be awarded to a student currently enrolled in the Electronics and Computer Technology program to assist with tuition, books and/or fees.

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

have a minimum 2.5 grade point average;
be enrolled in six credit hours; and
be enrolled in the Electronics and Computer Technology program.

Eligible applicants will demonstrate financial need and be enrolled in a Liberal Arts Program. Student should be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours of Liberal Arts-related coursework during semester and be a Liberal Arts declared major.

The Wabash Valley Lori Bear Memorial Scholarship has been established by family and friends to provide an annual scholarship to a Medical Assisting student who has been accepted into the program and has GPA of 3.0 or higher. Priority is giving to a non-traditional student aged 35 or older.

The LTL General Scholarship was established by Louise T. Lamkin, wife of Gerald Lamkin, the past president of Ivy Tech Community College. It is intended to recognize the value of an Ivy Tech Community College education and be a catalyst in inspiring others to donate funds to assist Ivy Tech students in pursuing their educational goals. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must: -have completed the FAFSA and have a minimum 3.0 grade point average in high school or a post-secondary institution -be enrolled in a degree program -be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours per semester.

The Wabash Valley Master Gardener's Scholarship is given annually to a student enrolled in the Agriculture program to assist with tuition, books and/or fees. It is valued at \$500 and will be paid in one semester.

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must be:

a resident of Vigo, Clay or Sullivan counties,
have a minimum 2.5 grade point average, and
be enrolled in a minimum of twelve credit hours.

The Michael Stolfe Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of Michael Stolfe, a long-time, outstanding faculty member in Design Technology at Ivy Tech Community College -Wabash Valley.

To be eligible for this scholarship, students must:

have a minimum 3.0 grade point average in high school or a post-secondary institution;
be enrolled in the Design Technology program; and
be enrolled for a minimum of six credit hours per semester.

The Oakley Foundation Endowed Scholarship was established to assist students who demonstrate financial need while attending Ivy Tech Community College - Wabash Valley. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester).

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

- complete the Ivy Tech scholarship application,
- have 2.0 grade point average,
- be a degree-seeking student,
- and be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.

The Plumbers & Steamfitters Local #157 Members Memorial Scholarship was established by the Plumbers & Steamfitters Local #157 with the purpose of providing immediate family members of Local #157 with financial support to pursue their educational goals at Ivy Tech Community College. To be eligible for this scholarship, students must possess a minimum average in high school or a post-secondary institution, be enrolled in at least six credit hours, be in good standing, and demonstrate financial need. Award is only given to a member of Local #175, their legal spouse, children or grandchildren. Applicants must self-report this information to Ivy Tech Staff during the application process and candidate's eligibility will be verified wth the local primary business contact.

The Practical Nursing Scholarship was established in 1995 to support students enrolled in this program. Student must have a GPA of 3.0 or greater to be eligible.

The Ralph G. & Mary L. Barkley Scholarship was established to provide educational opportunities to students who demonstrate financial need, a positive attitude and good work ethic. It is intended for tuition and books only, and the number of scholarships given are to be divided equally between males and females. The value of the scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester).

To be eligible for a scholarship, the student must:

- Be enrolled in a healthcare, business, electronics or computer-related program;
- Have a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average; and
- Have never been convicted of a drug or alcohol related offense.

Parke County Learning Center Student additional criterial to be established

Criteria needs established

Each fall and spring semester, one scholarship applicant from each major area of study (division) will be awarded a \$200 scholarship. If a division does not have any applicants, that division scholarship may be transferred to another division. In the event a scholarship is transferred, it will go to the division with the most applicants. An applicant may receive only ONE SGA scholarship per academic year.

To be eligible, recipients must:

Be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) credit hours;
Be a degree-seeking student;
Have a 2.5 or higher grade point average (GPA); and
Have completed the Ivy Tech Community College scholarship application.

The Wabash Valley Smith-Walkup Family Scholarship provides scholarship opportunities for Sullivan County residents who are attending classes at Ivy Tech - Wabash Valley. The \$250 annual award is to assist with educational expenses.

To be eligible, the recipient must:

be a Sullivan County resident,
enroll in courses through the Wabash Valley Region, and
demonstrate financial need.

Preference is given to students attending part-time.

The Staff Senate Scholarship was established by the Ivy Tech- Wabash Valley Staff Senate group to assist with the cost of books and with technology fees for Ivy Tech support staff furthering their education at the College. Consideration of selection will be in the following order: Hourly Staff employee (full-time or part-time), immediate family member (dependent or spouse) of Hourly Staff full-time or part-time employee. If the scholarship is not applied for by either of these groups, it may be awarded to a general student applicant enrolled in 12 contact hours and meeting the academic requirements. The annual award is valued at \$250. Scholarship eligibility: -must be enrolled in at least six credit hours during the semester of request -have a

The Wabash Valley Study Abroad Scholarship was established to assist a student with the costs involved in a study abroad opportunity.

The recipient of this award must:

Be registered in an Ivy Tech study abroad program for the current school year;
Have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher; and
Be enrolled in 6 or more credit hours.

The Wabash Valley Terre Haute PEO Scholarship is given annually to a female student to assist with tuition, books and/or fees. It is valued at \$300 and will be paid in one semester.

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must:

have completed FAFSA,

have a minimum 3.0 grade point average,

be in good academic standing,

have completed at least one semester of coursework, and

be enrolled in a minimum of twelve credit hours.

This scholarship is made possible through the generosity of Terre Haute Regional Hospital with the purpose of assisting students interested in the healthcare profession with their educational expenses. The value of this scholarship is \$1000 (\$500 each semester).

To be eligible for the Wabash Valley Regional Hospital Scholarship, students must:

be seeking a degree in a health-related program,

meet and maintain standards of progress, and

be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.

The Terre Haute Savings Bank Scholarship program was established to encourage dislocated workers, women returning to the workforce, minorities and persons receiving public assistance to enroll or return to school. The goal is to enhance opportunities for economic self-sufficiency through post-secondary education. Through the generosity of Terre Haute Savings Bank, \$200 scholarships will be awarded each year to students enrolling at Ivy Tech Community College -Wabash Valley.

Scholarship eligibility, students must be:

a dislocated worker,

woman returning to the workforce,

minority, or a student currently receiving public assistance.

The priority order for awards will be:

Students enrolling at Ivy Tech for the first time.

Students not currently receiving other financial aid.

Students attending part-time.

Established by The Indiana and Illinois Tire Dealers Association, scholarship criteria is as follows.

This scholarship is valued at \$3,000 and is to be used to cover the cost of tuition, required books and other class-related materials.

To be eligible, students must:

be enrolled in a health-related program;
maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or greater;
meet and maintain standards of progress; and
demonstrate financial need.
