

TEAS Test by Appointment-Bloomington

STEP 1: Create ATI account

To avoid delays or rescheduling, students must create an ATI test account PRIOR to test day.

1. Go to www.atitesting.com
2. Under the login, click on Create an Account
3. Create your account using your **Campus Connect username and password**, click **Continue**
4. Complete security questions and answers, click **Continue**
5. Complete demographic information, click **Continue**
6. **Institution information page** (important): Type Ivy Tech and scroll down and **select Ivy Tech Bloomington ASN** for nursing or **Ivy Tech Bloomington TEAS Health Services** for all other testing, click **Continue**.
7. Enter your **student ID# (C#)** If you don't know it, check campus connect, click **Continue**
8. Check **Yes you consent**, then **Continue**
9. Check **Yes you agree**, then click **Register**

STEP 2: Schedule and Pay online

Go to: www.ivytech.edu/schedulenow 2 days in advance (**48 hours**)

If you are an enrolled Ivy Tech student, login as a Student with your Campus Connect credentials. If you are taking the TEAS test for another institution, please login as a Non Ivy Tech student.

Note: TEAS payment is valid for up to 60 days.

* **Avoid a reschedule test fee:** Call or e-mail at least 24 to 72 hours before appointment time. **No refund will be issued after 60 days or before 24 hour notice.**

STEP 3: Test Day

Go to Testing Center room A200

Bring a non-expired Govt. Issued photo ID

Bring your ATI username and password

Please take care of any personal needs PRIOR to signing in for your test.

TIPS:

- *No calculators allowed. There is a built-in one on the program.*
- *Please dress in layers to adjust to the climate in the Testing Center. However, **NO outdoor jackets or hoodies permitted.***

- ATI TEAS exam contains multiple-choice questions in **four sections**:

1. For the **Reading Section**, you are allowed **64 minutes to answer 53 questions**
2. For the **Math Section**, you are allowed **54 minutes to answer 36 questions**
3. For the **Science Section**, you are allowed **63 minutes to answer 53 questions**
4. For the **English Section**, you are allowed **28 minutes to answer 28 questions**

- **FYI:** Please make sure you answer all questions in each section. **Unanswered questions will be scored as incorrect.**

For each section, you will see a timer at the top of your screen that displays the amount of time remaining for that section. Please be aware of the time you have remaining in each section—you will not be allowed to revisit any section once its time is finished.
