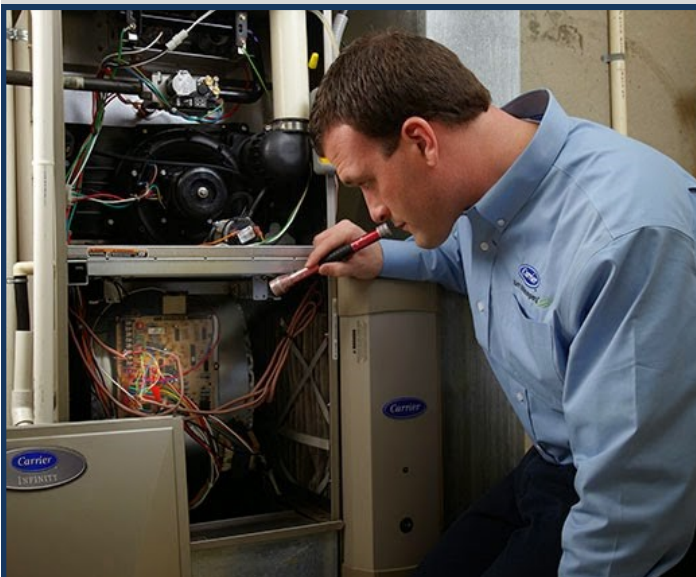




Fundamentals of HVAC and Building Maintenance

This introductory class teaches students basic job skills required for HVAC care and building maintenance. It lays a comprehensive foundation by providing an overview of the field, including carpentry, plumbing, electrical, general maintenance, and heating & cooling. Students will leave this course prepared to sit for the EPA 608 Refrigerant Recovery Certification Exam, as well as with the basic skills required by most potential employers to obtain an entry-level job in the HVAC, building maintenance, or refrigeration fields.

- ⇒ General Building Maintenance (includes plumbing)
- ⇒ Heating Fundamentals/Heating Service
- ⇒ Basic Refrigeration
- ⇒ Introduction to the Workplace and Safety

- ⇒ EPA 608 Refrigerant Recovery Certification Exam
