**Important Details about Choice Scholarship**

Ivy Tech Community College Northeast offers up to fifteen tuition-only \$1,000 (\$500 Fall/\$500 Spring) scholarships to graduating high school seniors who plan to attend the College during the 2015-2016 academic year. The amount of the scholarship may be affected if the recipient qualifies for other types of tuition-only assistance.

These are merit scholarships. Eligibility is not based upon financial need. The Ivy Tech Choice Scholarship Committee will select recipients after reviewing the applicant's academic performance, work experience, school and/or community leadership or activities, personal statement, and two written recommendations.

Scholarships will be distributed to students entering any Ivy Tech Northeast program.

**Scholarship Instructions:**

1. Complete each section of the application
2. Attach personal statement, two letters of recommendation, and up-to-date high school transcript. (*See sections IV and V for details.*)
3. Submit all materials together to Ivy Tech Northeast by the stated deadline of **March 15th 2015.** (*Note– Incomplete applications will not be considered by the committee.*)
