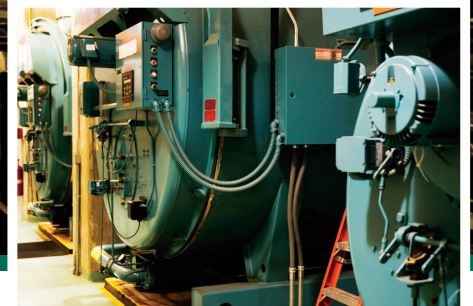


# ASOPE

## FACILITIES OPERATING ENGINEERS | LICENSING SEMINARS 2022



### WHAT IS IT?

Ivy Tech Community College and the American Society of Power Engineers, Inc. (ASOPE) have partnered to provide professional training on boiler operation and maintenance. The seminars are designed for individuals currently working in the field. Participants will be introduced to a thorough overview of boilers, including operation, maintenance and how to reduce energy costs. This knowledge and these skills are necessary to operate a facilities plant safely and efficiently.

### Third Class Seminar

Introduces a thorough overview of boilers, operation and maintenance, as well as the basic knowledge and skills necessary to safely and efficiently operate a facilities plant. Prepares participants to sit for the ASOPE Facility Plant Operator Third Class License exam.

### Second Class Seminar

Trains the operator in reducing energy costs and maintenance headaches in an effort to increase production profits. Prepares participants to sit for the ASOPE Facility Plant Operator Second Class License exam. To sit for the Second Class License exam, you must have one year operating experience and held the Facility Plant Operator Third Class license for one year and/or proof of three years of operating experience.

### First Class Seminar

Takes the knowledge students have acquired and puts it all together to operate the plant in a safe and efficient operation. Prepares participants to sit for the ASOPE Facility Plant Operator First Class License exam. Participants must be able to lead the employees under their supervision by a true knowledge of the job. To sit for the First Class License exam, you must have two years operating experience and held the Facility Plant Operator Second Class License for one year and/or proof of four years of operating experience.

### WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Because boiler operation and maintenance responsibility falls under many different individuals within an organization, anyone associated with boilers should consider taking this course, especially:

- Facilities Managers/Supervisors
- Steam Plant Maintenance Personnel
- Boiler Operators
- Hydronic Operators

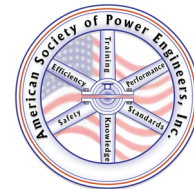
