News You Can Use

- Beginning Fall 2023, eligible students will be assessed a per credit hour Ivy+ Textbook Fee
- Opt-out will be available, but it is not recommended
- Opt-out Details
 - Students will opt-out for the entire term or semester
 - Fall 2023 Opt-out begins on July 24 and will be through the last 100% refund date of the earliest starting class
 - Students can change their opt-out status during the designated window
 - Opt-out information will be available on our Ivy+ Textbook website
