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The FAFSA is used by most colleges, including Ivy Tech, to determine eligibility for many types of financial assistance including grants, loans, federal work study programs, and more. Some types of funding are awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis, so it is important to file your FAFSA as soon as you are able.

Subject: Learn your way

There's no reason to be nervous about your first term at Ivy Tech Community College. We're here to help you every step of the way! Reach out to your local <u>enrollment center</u> if you have any questions.

As you prepare for registration, you'll want to consider how you want to take classes. Whether you're taking courses online, virtually, or in-person, you'll be able to get to know your peers. Our average class size is about 10 students. So, your instructors have the time and resources to help students on an individual basis.

Familiarize yourself with the course format you'll be able to choose from. Here is a list of each type:

- **Traditional** classes are exactly what you might expect. In this format the instructor and students gather in an on-campus classroom at a scheduled time.
- **Online** classes are where there is no scheduled class meeting time but students do have plenty of opportunities to interact with their instructor through lvyLearn. Course assignments will be assigned and completed through your lvyLearn class page on a weekly (or regular) basis.
- **Virtual** classes are similar to traditional classes but instead of meeting in the classroom you meet in a live video call at a scheduled time.
- **Blended** classes mix the traditional course format with virtual or online formats. There is a scheduled class time, but you'll spend some days in the classroom and some days in an online learning space.
- Learn Anywhere courses are taught in the classroom at a scheduled time but can also be accessed in a virtual format. Attendance at each class session is mandatory but students have the choice of whether they would like to attend in person or virtually on a week-to-week basis.

We want to make sure the classes you take are the right fit for you. In order to accomplish this, we need to determine your reading, writing, and math skills through the <u>assessment process</u>. During the Ivy Tech assessment process, we can measure where your skills are currently at in several different ways, including ACT, SAT, or PSAT scores; high school GPA; previous college credit you've earned; or through the use of an assessment tool.

If you didn't have your test scores available to upload when you applied, that's OK! You have until the end of the term for which you applied to return to your application and upload your assessment documents.

Did you know most Ivy Tech students qualify for Financial Aid? And Ivy Tech gives away about \$8 million a year in <u>scholarships</u>. Higher education doesn't need to come at a higher cost!

An important step in preparing for the start of the semester is setting a financial plan in place to help manage your cost of attendance. At Ivy Tech, we offer several payment methods, which provides you with low-cost options for budgeting tuition and fees. Two payment options that are important for you to be aware of are financial aid and tuition payment plans.

Financial aid is need-based aid provided by the federal government and includes things like grants, Pell grants, loans, federal work study, and more. You can apply for financial aid by filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at <u>studentaid.gov</u>. Any funds you receive from the FAFSA can be used toward your tuition bill.

A <u>tuition payment plan</u> breaks your payments down into smaller, monthly increments, allowing you to slowly pay your bill over time, rather than having to pay the total amount at once. Payment plans come with no additional interest, so you will not accrue more cost each month.
