- All students will be expected to come to the class that they have signed up for, at the scheduled time, for the scheduled duration. All students are expected to attend at least 80% of the schedule.

- Students who complete an 80% participation rate, will be eligible for financial help with the HSE HiSET exam fees. So for all schedules this means:

6 week Classes	80% :	Must be in attendance for at least	10 CLASSES
8 week Classes	80% :	Must be in attendance for at least	13 CLASSES
16 Week Classes	80% :	Must be in attendance for at least	13 CLASSES
