## Prepositions

Prepositions show relationships between people, time, objects, and locations. They can be used to express positions, movement, possession, time, and how an action happens.

Not sure which preposition to use? Here are four helpful resources to discover the best option:



Search a prepositional phrase in Google. If most results match, your preposition choice is likely correct. If not, Google will likely suggest an alternative preposition.



A collocation dictionary (e.g. http://www.ozdic.com/ ) shows some common words (including prepositions) that follow a particular word.
