Abby Noblitt, BS
Owner, VIP Kinder College
2023 Distinguished Alumni Award Recipient

Abby Noblitt is the owner and director of VIP Kinder College, a family childcare facility based in Terre Haute serving infants through preschool-aged children. Abby graduated from Ivy Tech Community College Terre Haute magna cum laude in 2021 with her Associate of Science in early childhood education. Abby then transferred to Saint Mary-of-the-Woods College where she earned her Bachelor of Science and state licensure in pre-kindergarten to 3rd grade and graduated summa cum laude in 2022. Currently, Abby is planning to earn her Master of Education in teaching, learning, and curriculum through Indiana University.

Abby worked for VIP Kinder College before enrolling at Ivy Tech to earn her associate degree. While pursuing her post-secondary education, Abby served as the director of VIP Kinder College and managed the facility's staff while also juggling her own family and being an active member of her church.

VIP Kinder College was established in 1991 with the mission of helping children to learn through play, concrete experiences, and interactions with their environment, peers, and adults. VIP Kinder College is rated as a high-quality childcare program and recently received a grant from United Way of the Wabash Valley to help establish a new center, VIP Kinder College South. Indiana's childcare quality rating and improvement system, Paths to Quality, is expected to award VIP Kinder College with the highest quality rating, Level 4, later this spring. In Ivy Tech Terre Haute's service area, only 14 facilities have achieved that rating.

Abby is the recipient of the 2023 Distinguished Alumni Award for Ivy Tech Community College Terre Haute, honoring her personal success and unwavering passion for early childhood education, her encouragement for her staff to further their education at Ivy Tech, and her commitment to the children and families her childcare facility serves.

One of her nominators said, "Abby is a great advocate for children and a firmly entrenched leader in our local early childhood education community. Parents in the community have trusted her with the care and guidance of their children for many years as she uses her expertise to help their children reach their full potential."
