Requirements for Admission

- 1. You must be at least 18 years old (21 years old to drive cargo across state borders).
- 2. You must pass the Department of Transportation (D.O.T.) physical and drug screen.
- 3. You must have an active valid motor vehicle operator license for at least one year.
- 4. You must have the ability to read, speak, and write English well enough to pass the commercial driver's license test and to perform your job duties: converse with the general public, understand highway signs and signals, respond to official questions, and make entries on reports and records.

NOTE: Residents outside of Indiana must obtain their Class A CDL permit before enrollment.

✓	Start Trucking School and begin your journey towards a successful career in the transportation industry
✓	Make arrangements in your personal life to allow great attendance and the ability to study at home, as this class requires your full commitment to be successful. I understand that I must complete the course at an 80% proficiency in order to take the CDL skills test at the end of the course
✓	D.O.T. Physicals and a 5 Panel Urine Drug Screen will be completed either, prior to the class start or Day 1 or Day 2 of class. No student is allowed inside a Semi Truck without a NEGATIVE drug screen within 30 days of your start date. CBD Oil will test positive for Marijuana
✓	Once all tests are completed, you must have your entire 5-page D.O.T. physical in hand at the BMV or DMV to obtain your permit
✓	Must have the ability to read, speak, and write English well enough to pass the state written and driving commercial driver's license exams and to perform your job duties: converse with the general public, understand highway signs and signals, respond to official questions, and make entries on reports and record
✓	The Class A CDL tests are taken at any BMV or DMV. You must pass the following tests at an 80% pass rate: - General Knowledge (50 Questions) - Air Brakes (25 Questions) - Combination Vehicles (20 Questions)
✓	Begin working on your Class A CDL Permit as you will need to have it in hand upon completion of the first 40 hours. Passing the General Knowledge Exam is highly recommended prior to the first day of class. Failure to comply could result in removal from the class or enrolled in a class at a later date
✓	You will receive a phone call, email, or text 4-5 days prior to your start date to confirm your attendance. If you do not receive confirmation contact the school immediately as you might not be on the class list
✓	If your tuition is sponsored or grant funded, please communicate with your Industrial Programs Coordinator to ensure your seat in the class is confirmed once your tuition has been allocated. I understand that I cannot start the course before approved by the grantee
