

APPROVAL OF DEGREE PROGRAMS

Resolution Number 2025-46

WHEREAS, the School of Information Technology (“IT”) at Ivy Tech Community College (“College”) has undertaken a comprehensive realignment of its programs to reduce duplication, enhance student outcomes, and better align curriculum with Indiana’s evolving labor-market needs; and

WHEREAS, as part of this realignment, the College has identified the need to add certificate programs that provide streamlined pathways in IT Infrastructure and Operations and Information Systems and Analytics, and degree and certificate programs in Applied Artificial Intelligence in the state of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Academics and Student Experience Committee of the State Board of Trustees has reviewed the following proposed programs and recommended their approval:

- Certificate in Information Systems and Analytics
- Certificate in IT Infrastructure and Operations
- Technical Certificate in IT Infrastructure and Operations
- Professional Certificate in Applied Artificial Intelligence
- Technical Certificate in Applied Artificial Intelligence
- Associate of Applied Science in Applied Artificial Intelligence

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 21-18-9-5, the Indiana Commission for Higher Education must review and approve any proposed degree programs; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Trustees do hereby authorize and direct the President and any other appropriate, designated College employee to execute all necessary documents and present the same to the Commission for Higher Education for the approval of the proposed programs.
