Ivy Tech Community College is investing in Indiana's future, starting with its youngest Hoosiers. With a \$21.9 million grant awarded by the Lilly Endowment, Ivy Tech is expanding early childhood education programs, creating new credentials, apprenticeships, and transfer pathways.

About the Program

The Early Childhood Educator apprenticeship program is available to individuals interested in early care who have a desire to advance their skills that will progress them towards a long-term career. The apprenticeship program combines classroom learning with real-world application of concepts while working with a mentor. Apprentices will complete the Ivy Tech Community College Early Childhood certificate program and earn multiple industry recognized certifications.
