



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









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







Question 12. Would you recommend the following schedule changes (select all that apply)






Question 17. Which of the following means of taking a class would you choose?




Question 18. Which of the following means of taking a class do you feel provided the best in-depth learning?

Question 19. Do you plan to transfer to a four year college after graduating from the Ivy Tech Human Services Program? 69 responses






