

How to Access your Academic Completion Plan

- Log in to Mylvy with your username@ivytech.edu and password at <u>https://my.ivytech.edu</u>
- 2. Click on **Degree CompletionTracker** in the Quick Links section.
- 3. Click on the **Plan tab** and open your **Academic Completion Plan (ACP).** If you have multiple, click on the plan with the star highlighted.
- ****** If you don't have an Academic Completion Plan, schedule an appointment with your Advisor.

How to Schedule an Appointment with your Advisor

- All **degree-seeking** students assigned an advisor based on their student status or program of study.
- Log in to Mylvy with your username@ivytech.edu and password at <u>https://my.ivytech.edu</u>
- 2. Select **Schedule an Appointment** in the Quick Links section.
- 3. Locate your Academic Advisor or Faculty Advisor, click the three dots next to their name and click **Schedule**. Find a time that works best for you

How to Schedule Classes in Schedule Builder

- Step 1: Log into Mylvy (https://my.ivytech.edu)
- Step 2: Click Schedule Builder in the Quick Links Section
- **Step 3:** Select your <u>Term</u> and Save.
- **Step 4:** Select your <u>home campus</u> and <u>IvyOnline</u> (for online classes).

Step 5: Confirm your address and acknowledge the COVID statement.

Step 6: Choose your optional filters for your course search – course status (open, open and full, open and full with waitlist open), instruction modes (traditional, online, etc.), and part of term (first 8 weeks, 16 weeks, etc.)

Step 7: Click Add Course. You can select classes on your Academic Completion Plan, search by course number (CRN), or by name.

Step 8: Add any breaks (times you do not wish to take classes) to assist in finding the optimal course schedule for you.

Step 9: Click on Generate Schedules. Click View to compare and find your favorite schedule. When you're ready, click Add to Shopping Cart.

Step 10: From your Shopping Cart, click on Register. Enter the PIN you received from your advisor. The system will notify you if you were successfully registered or if there are issues with your registration. You can print or e-mail your schedule at any point during this process.

		Discuss Your Major	Your major may require additional applications, specific timelines or additional evaluations. Discuss program options with your Advisor and Career Coach in the CCEC.
		Review Assessment Scores / Waivers	Review your Knowledge Assessment scores or other available assessment scores. Discuss options for scheduling your required Math and English courses to ensuretimely completion.
		Create Academic Completion Plan (ACP)	Work with your Advisor to create a plan to complete all required courses for your program. This plan will lay out anticipated courses by semester as a ROAD MAP TO COMPLETION . See Reverse for instructions on how to access your ACP.
		Select Courses for Registration	After a discussion with your advisor and a review of courses available for the uccoming semester, register immediately, or follow the instructions on the reverse side to register online. 		Check on Satisfactory Academic Progress	Discuss your Satisfactory Academic Progress with your Advisor to ensure you are not in danger of losing your financial aid or being placed on academic warning. To check your SAP, click Status under your Financial Aid Tab in My Ivy.
	Confirm payment arrangements to avoid classes being dropped for non-payment		At Ivy Tech, you can file a FAFSA to see if you are eligible for grants and student loans.
