## "The "Nightingale Pledge"

#### **Recitation of the Pledge:**

"I solemnly pledge, in the presence of this assembly, to faithfully practice my profession of nursing. I will do all in my power to make and maintain the highest standards and practices of my profession.

I will hold in confidence all personal matters committed to my keeping in the practice of my calling. I will assist the physician in his work and will devote myself to the welfare of my patients, my family, and my community.

I will endeavor to fulfill my rights and privileges as a good citizen and take my share of responsibility in promoting the health and welfare of the community.

I will constantly endeavor to increase my knowledge and skills in nursing and to use them wisely. I will zealously seek to nurse those who are ill wherever they may be and whenever they are in need.

I will be active in assisting others in safeguarding and promoting the health and happiness of mankind."

The original Nightingale Pledge was composed by Lystra Gretter, an instructor of nursing at the Harper Hospital in Detroit, Michigan, with input from a committee at the Farrand Training School for Nurses and was first used by its graduating class in the spring of 1893. It is an adaptation of the Hippocratic Oath taken by physicians. The pledge reflects nursing practice and the role of the nurse at the time it was written, but nevertheless it encompasses the underlying values of the nursing profession such as: duty to care, ethical principle of non-malfeasance, confidentiality, and client advocacy
